Receipt & adoption of the President's annual report

Matthew: The school tuckshop is our main source of income, followed by grants. The tuckshop brought in around \$278,000 in sales, up 10% from last year, and after wages and food costs, the tuckshop made approximately \$3,300 profit. P&C costs not related to the tuckshop came to around \$10,500 with an additional \$3,000 for wages for the IT trainees.

In 2023 the P&C contributed:

- \$35,000 on for architectural plans for an upgrade to the tuckshop to support grant applications.
- \$2,000 on a new computer and printer for the tuckshop
- \$3,000 in wages for two school-based trainees to work in the school IT, with another \$9,000 committed for 2024, which we hope will provide valuable IT support for staff and students, as well as support two students to work towards their career goals.
- \$7,000 for the annual careers expo from the Isaac Regional Council.
- \$32,000 for water bubblers upon installation, as promised in 2022.

I would like to thank the executive committee for volunteering their time to help run the P&C, Vice President Amanda Smith, Secretary Rebecca Huggett, and Treasurer Gabby Halverson. I would like to thank committee member Lauren McCulloch for volunteering her time to do the accounts each week, a significant time investment on her behalf and a great help to our P&C. I would also thank all parents that regularly attend our monthly meetings to represent our community of parents.
