President's Annual Report:

Last year, the P&C state conference celebrated 75 years of P&C's in state education, and the governing body sponsored our P&C to send a representative to the annual conference. I learned that that across Queensland, state school P&C's raised approximately \$86 million in 2021. If you were to assign a dollar value on the hours that committees and volunteers put into monthly meetings, fundraising events, tuckshops, uniform shops, and grant applications, this figure would likely be over \$100 million dollars in 2021.

I would like to thank all of our members for their support in 2022, especially Lauren McCulloch for volunteering her time to do the accounts each week, a significant time investment on her behalf and a great help to our P&C. In particular I would like to thank her for the work she did to get our accounts onto the new accounting software in order to make our audit process cheaper and easier. This has saved the P&C over \$1500 in audit and software costs this year.

Thank you to Rebecca, Melissa and Jackie for their time on the executive committee. I have enjoyed working with you all and thank you for the time you have dedicated to the P&C.

Finally, I encourage everyone here to consider nominating for an executive position.
