




* Lines are informed by the subject interest and combinations of subjects students chose in smorgasbord selection exercise – a subject can not be selected twice

- If any of the above occurs, you will asked to reselect your subjects





Students and parents will be notified via email of their subject selection success for 2026 at the end of the year.




