This letter contains important information about the 2026 Student Resource Scheme (SRS) and Moranbah State High School 2026 subject levies.

Please see attached the 2026 Student Resource Scheme (SRS) information and the 2026 Year 11 & 12 students and Moranbah State High School 2026 Subject levies for Year 11 & 12.

For 2026, Moranbah State High School acknowledges the cost-of-living pressures on families especially as students reach senior schooling, we are proud to advise that in 2026 no out of pocket costs will be charged for Senior Students.

The attached documents outline the resources included in the SRS, which are provided to each participating student as part of the Textbook and Resource Allowance.

Subject Levies are separate to SRS and are for subjects that are not covered in the SRS or utilise a higher volume of consumables eg. Cooking Ingredients, art supplies.
